LEGAL BASIS OF TREATMENT

The personal data indicated on this page are processed by the data controller for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party or for the execution of pre-contractual measures taken at the request of the same or for the legitimate interest of the data controller for improvement of their products and services.

PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING.

The data are processed for technical navigation issues as better specified under "Types of data processed" The personal data requested in any contact form or with other similar systems are regulated by appropriate information.

DATA PROCESSING PLACE.

The processing connected to the web services of this site takes place at the headquarters of the owner and its secondary offices and is only handled by technical staff of the office in charge of processing.

TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED.

Browsing data The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This is information that is not collected to be associated with identified interested parties, but which by their very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified.

This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by users connecting to the site, the addresses in the Uniform Resource Identifier (URI) notation of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (success, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's computer environment.

These data are used for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to check its correct functioning and are deleted immediately after processing. The data could be used to ascertain responsibility in case of hypothetical computer crimes against the site: except for this eventuality, at present the data on web contacts do not persist for more than seven days.
